- 14 (g) National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day on July 27; $((\frac{g}{g}))$
- 15 <u>(h)</u> National POW/MIA Recognition Day on the third Friday in
- 16 September; ((and (h))) (i) Veterans' Day on November 11th; and (j)
- 17 Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day on December 7th. If the designated day
