- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.80.020 and 2016 c 27 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
 - The legislature hereby authorizes creation of regional transportation planning organizations within the state. Each regional transportation planning organization shall be formed through the voluntary association of local governments within a county, or within geographically contiguous counties. Each organization shall:
 - (1) Encompass at least one complete county;
- (2)(a) Have a population of at least one hundred thousand, (b)
 have a population of at least seventy-five thousand and contain a
 Washington state ferries terminal, (c) have a population of at least
 forty thousand and cover a geographic area of at least five thousand
- 17 <u>square miles</u>, or <u>(d)</u> contain a minimum of three counties; and
 18 (3) Have as members all counties within the region, and at
- 18 (3) Have as members all counties within the region, and at least 19 sixty percent of the cities and towns within the region representing
- 20 a minimum of seventy-five percent of the cities' and towns'
- 21 population.
