- 13 (a) "Residential custody services" means a comprehensive program 14 established pursuant to RCW 72.05.130 for the custody, care, education. 15 treatment, instruction, guidance, control, and 16 rehabilitation of youth committed to a state juvenile rehabilitation 17 facility.
- (b) "State juvenile rehabilitation facility" means an institution as defined in RCW 13.40.020(13), a community facility as defined in RCW 72.05.020(1), or other juvenile rehabilitation facility operated by the department.
