- 2 "(1) \$500,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 3 appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, from the
- 4 workforce education investment account and \$500,000, or as much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year
- 6 ending June 30, 2021, from the workforce education investment account
- 7 provided solely for the workforce education and training coordinating
- 8 board to contract with the Washington west sound stem network to
- 9 develop and implement the controls programmer apprenticeship pilot
- 10 program. The pilot program must provide a pathway for youth to earn a
- 11 high school diploma and postsecondary credentials while being employed
- 12 as a controls programmer apprentice. Among other things, the pilot
- 13 program must:
- 14 (a) Create private-public partnerships that lead to apprenticeship
- 15 programs and provide opportunities for youth and adults to access
- 16 family-wage jobs;
- 17 (b) Convene meetings with employers, school districts, and
- 18 colleges that result in apprentice hires; and
- 19 (c) Include employers from maritime, aviation, construction,
- 20 healthcare, commercial real estate, and other high-demand sectors.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Provides funding for the Workforce Training and Education Coordinating Board to contract with the Washington west sound stem network to develop and implement the controls programmer apprenticeship pilot program.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT:</u> Increases Workforce Education Investment Account by \$1,000,000.
