1 On page 8, beginning on line 38, after "consulted with" strike "a
2 federally recognized Indian tribe when the project may involve
3 archeological, cultural, or natural resource sites of significance to
4 the tribe" and insert "the federally recognized Indian tribe or tribes
5 with cultural or treaty interests in the area when the project may
6 involve archaeological, cultural, natural resource sites of
7 significance to the tribe, or other treaty reserved rights or
8 interests. This consultation is to supplement rather than replace
9 tribal consultation under Executive Order 05-05 or subsequent
10 executive orders issued to protect cultural resources and treaty
11 reserved rights or interests"

EFFECT: Requires a sponsoring local government that is applying for a state contribution toward a local revitalization project to provide documentation in its application showing that it has consulted with a federally recognized Indian tribe when the project involves an area in which the tribe may have treaty reserved rights or interests. Specifies that the consultation requirement supplements rather than replaces consultation required by an executive order.
