8 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.655  
9 RCW to read as follows:

10 By September 1, 2020, the office of the superintendent of public  
11 instruction shall adopt essential academic learning requirements and  
12 grade-level expectations that identify the knowledge and skills that  
13 all public school students need to be global citizens in a global  
14 society with an appreciation for the contributions of diverse  
15 cultures. These essential academic learning requirements and grade-  
16 level expectations must be periodically updated to incorporate best  
17 practices in ethnic studies."

18 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any  
19 internal references accordingly.

21 through "the" on line 12 and insert "The"

22 On page 2, beginning on line 13, after "committee" strike all  
23 material through "advise" on line 14 and insert "to:

25 On page 2, line 17, after "resources" strike "required" and  
26 insert ": (i) Described"

1 On page 2, beginning on line 17, after "act" strike all material  
2 through "develop" on line 18 and insert "; and (ii) for use in  
3 elementary schools; and

4 (b) Develop"

5 On page 2, at the beginning of line 21, strike "(d)" and insert  
6 "(2)"

7 On page 2, line 26, strike all material through "Indian"

8 On page 2, line 27, strike "(2)" and insert "(3)"

9 On page 2, after line 27, insert the following:

10 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** The legislature intends that nothing in  
11 this act supersedes the use of the since time immemorial: tribal  
12 sovereignty in Washington state curriculum, developed as required  
13 under RCW 28A.320.170(1) (b)."

14 Correct the title.

EFFECT: (1) Requires the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) to adopt, and periodically update, essential academic learning requirements and grade-level expectations that identify the knowledge and skills that all public school students need to be global citizens in a global society with an appreciation for the contributions of diverse cultures; and revises the intent section accordingly.

(2) Directs the Ethnic Studies Advisory Committee to advise, assist, and make recommendations to the OSPI regarding the identification and use of ethnic studies materials and resources for use in elementary schools.

(3) Removes the Governor's Office of Indian Affairs from the Ethnic Studies Advisory Committee.

(4) Provides that the Legislature intends that nothing in this act supersedes the use of the Since Time Immemorial: Tribal Sovereignty in Washington curriculum.

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
