<u>EFFECT:</u> Provides additional funding for OSPI to subsidize various dual credit course costs and fees for students eligible for the federal free and reduced-price meals program, as well as for grants to school districts to provide outreach to students about dual credit programs and to increase the number of teachers approved to teach college in the high school courses. Provides grant funding through OSPI for school districts to purchase secondary career and technical education equipment. Decreases general fund-state appropriation in fiscal year 2021 from institutions of higher education to not exceed the ratio of full-time equivalent nonfaculty exempt employees employed by the institution in fiscal year 2008, to full-time equivalent enrollments served by the institution in fiscal year 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
