EFFECT: Provides a 2 percent general wage increase to University of Washington represented and non-represented employees on July 1, 2020. Rejects the \$650 and \$700 one-time lump sum payments to certain represented and non-represented employees. Provides that represented employees with collective bargaining agreements subject to approval by the legislature must reach

agreements with the University of Washington to implement the conditional wage increase by July 1, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Reduces General Fund - State by \$2,320,000. Increases Other Funds by \$41,217,000.

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
