## HOUSE BILL 1968

1 AN ACT Relating to health plan coverage for contralateral 2 prophylactic mastectomies; and adding a new section to chapter 48.43 3 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.43 6 RCW to read as follows:

(1) Health plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2020,
shall provide benefits or coverage for contralateral prophylactic
mastectomies to covered individuals who:

(a) Are determined by their physician to be at a high risk ofdeveloping breast cancer in the contralateral breast;

12 (b) Have a genetic defect that predisposes them to breast cancer; 13 or

14 (c) Have a desire for symmetry and reconstruction of both breasts15 following removal of a breast due to breast cancer.

16 (2) (a) A health carrier is not required under this section to 17 provide for a referral to a nonparticipating health care provider, 18 unless the carrier does not have an appropriate health care provider 19 that is available and accessible to administer the procedure and that 20 is a participating health care provider with respect to such 21 procedure. 1 (b) If a health carrier refers an individual to a 2 nonparticipating health care provider pursuant to this section, 3 screening services or a resulting procedure, if any, must be provided 4 at no additional cost to the individual beyond what the individual 5 would otherwise pay for services provided by a participating health 6 care provider.

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
