1 AN ACT Relating to the collection of derelict fishing gear; and 2 amending RCW 77.12.865.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 77.12.865 and 2010 c 193 s 7 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (1) As used in this section and RCW 77.12.870, "derelict fishing 7 gear" includes lost or abandoned fishing nets, fishing lines, and 8 other commercial and recreational fishing equipment. The term does 9 not include lost or abandoned vessels or shellfish pots.

10 (2) The department, in partnership with the Northwest straits 11 commission, the department of natural resources, and other interested 12 parties, must publish guidelines for the safe removal and disposal of 13 derelict fishing gear. The guidelines may be updated as deemed 14 necessary by the department. The guidelines must be made available to 15 any person interested in derelict fishing gear removal.

16 (3) ((Derelict fishing gear removal conducted)) A person who 17 encounters derelict fishing gear may collect it and turn it in to a 18 fish and wildlife officer. No criminal or civil liability, including 19 under chapter 77.55 RCW, may be imposed by any court on a person for 20 actions taken in accordance with the quidelines prepared in 21 subsection (2) of this section ((is not subject to permitting under

- 1 RCW 77.55.021)), except upon proof of gross negligence or willful or
- 2 <u>wanton misconduct by the person</u>.
