- AN ACT Relating to trust water rights; and creating a new
- 2 section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1)The department of ecology shall 5 convene a work group of affected entities to study the design and use 6 of the state water trust, water banking and water transfers, and 7 tools to protect instream water rights from neighboring states and 8 make recommendations on policy improvements. The department 9 ecology shall invite representatives to serve on the work group from organizations including, but not limited to: 10
- 11 (a) Federally recognized Indian tribes;
- 12 (b) Local governments;
- 13 (c) Environmental advocacy organizations;
- 14 (d) The farming industry in Washington;
- 15 (e) Business interests; and
- 16 (f) Entities that have been directly involved with the 17 establishment of water banks.
- 18 (2) In addition to an invitation to participate on the work 19 group, the department of ecology shall also consult with affected

20 tribal governments upon request.
