1 AN ACT Relating to establishing a Travis alert outreach
2 demonstration campaign; creating a new section; and providing an
3 expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) A Travis alert pilot program is
6 created. By July 31, 2020, the Washington state military
7 department, in coordination with local jurisdictions, shall initiate
8 a pilot program to assess the benefits and availability of making
9 medical or disability information available to first responders in
10 advance of arrival at an emergency. As part of the pilot program, the
11 Washington state military department shall work with two
12 jurisdictions, one east of the crest of the Cascade mountains and one
13 west of the crest of the Cascade mountains, capable of providing
14 first responders with medical or disability information previously
15 submitted. The pilot program shall include an outreach campaign of no
16 longer than one month in each of the jurisdictions. By January 1,
17 2021, and in compliance with RCW 43.01.036, the Washington state
18 military department must submit a report to the appropriate
19 committees of the legislature summarizing the results of the pilot
20 program.
