1            TO THE WASHINGTON STATE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION, AND TO THE  
2 HONORABLE ROGER MILLAR, SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION, AND TO THE  
3 WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION:

4            We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of  
5 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled,  
6 respectfully represent and petition as follows:

7            WHEREAS, Washington has many active duty, reservists, veterans,  
8 and fallen war heroes, and communities around the state have  
9 different ways to honor their service; and

10           WHEREAS, Petty Officer First Class Regina Clark served in Desert  
11 Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

12           WHEREAS, Regina Clark was killed in combat on June 23, 2005, when  
13 a suicide car bomber and gunmen ambushed the convoy; and

14           WHEREAS, Regina Clark lived and worked in Lewis county; and

15           WHEREAS, She was a single mother, avid softball player, and a  
16 loved and respected member of the community;

17           NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the  
18 Washington State Transportation Commission commence proceedings to  
19 designate the bridge over the Skookumchuck river on state route  
20 number 507 between milepost 4 and milepost 5 as the Regina Clark  
21 memorial bridge to honor her service and for being the first Lewis  
22 county resident to be killed in Iraq.

1       BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately  
2 transmitted to the Washington State Transportation Commission, the  
3 Honorable Roger Millar, Secretary of the Washington State Department  
4 of Transportation, and the Washington State Department of  
5 Transportation.
