1 WHEREAS, George Washington, the first president of the United
2 States, who led the Continental Army to victory as Major General and
3 Commander-in-Chief of Revolutionary forces against Great Britain, and
4 dedicated his life to public service, was unanimously elected as the
5 first president at the constitutional convention; and

6 WHEREAS, Washington established precedent that subsequent
7 administrations would follow by leading with valor, respect, and
8 determination to ensure the United States would not succumb to a new
9 monarchy and that our young country would thrive; and

10 WHEREAS, Thomas Jefferson, the third president of the United
11 States, recognized that all were entitled to "certain inalienable
12 rights" and wrote the Declaration of Independence in pursuit of that
13 promise; and

14 WHEREAS, Abraham Lincoln, the sixteenth president of the United
15 States, who possessed unparalleled tact, resolve, and skill to lead
16 in divisive times, reaffirmed that life, liberty, and the pursuit of
17 happiness were rights belonging to all Americans; and

18 WHEREAS, Lincoln's administration ensured that "government of the
19 people, by the people, for the people" did not perish from the Earth;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, Theodore Roosevelt, the twenty-sixth president of the
22 United States of America, recognized that the beauty and majesty of
23 America was to be enjoyed by all and established the National Forest

1 Service in order to protect and preserve American lands, forests, and
2 species from companies and individuals who might disrupt these
3 wonders;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That on this eighteenth day of
5 February, 2019, the House of Representatives recognize and
6 commemorate the work of our great presidents throughout our nation's
7 history.
