1 WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Washington State House of
2 Representatives to recognize excellence in every field of endeavor;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The Columbia River High School Chieftains are the 2018
5 2A Boys' Soccer State Champions; and

6 WHEREAS, The 2018 Columbia River High School Chieftains Soccer
7 team held a perfect record of 23-0, without a tie, or forced extra
8 time all season long; and

9 WHEREAS, The Columbia River High School Chieftains defeated the
10 Burlington-Edison High School Tigers in the state championship at
11 Sunset Chev Stadium in Sumner, Washington on May 26, 2018, by a score
12 of 2-0; and

13 WHEREAS, The Columbia River Chieftains defeated the Clarkston
14 Bantams by a score of 3-2 at the Kiggins Bowl in Vancouver,
15 Washington on May 16, 2018, to advance to the quarter finals; and

16 WHEREAS, The Columbia River Chieftains defeated the Archbishop
17 Murray Wildcats by a score of 3-1 at the Kiggins Bowl on May 19,
18 2018, to advance to the semifinals; and

19 WHEREAS, The Columbia River Chieftains defeated the Franklin
20 Pierce Cardinals in a shutout by a score of 1-0 on May 25, 2018, at
21 Sunset Chev Stadium in the semifinals; and

1 WHEREAS, In the finals, Chieftain Jack Kolosvary scored a goal in
2 the 24th minute that deflected off a side wall and went into the goal
3 uncontested; and

4 WHEREAS, Despite their weaker record, the Burlington-Edison
5 Tigers fought hard against the Columbia River Chieftains; and

6 WHEREAS, Jack Kolosvary scored the Chieftain's second goal three
7 minutes into the second half off a penalty kick; and

8 WHEREAS, Midfielder Ryan Connop and Defender Candler Bolte were
9 both named to the Class 2A first team for their remarkable
10 achievements; and

11 WHEREAS, Forward Jake Connop, Midfielder Jack Kolosvary, and
12 Goalkeeper David Gonzalez were all named to the Class 2A second team
13 for their remarkable achievements; and

14 WHEREAS, Head Coach Filomon Afenegus was named 2A Coach of the
15 Year for his tremendous leadership;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State House
17 of Representatives congratulate the Columbia River High School soccer
18 team on their state championship, and congratulate their fans,
19 supportive alumni, and the entire community for this amazing
20 accomplishment; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
22 immediately transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House of
23 Representatives to the Columbia River High School Chieftains soccer
24 team and to Head Coach Filomon Afenegus.
