SENATE BILL 5633

State of Washington 66th Legislature 2019 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to supporting and expanding behavioral health workforce pathway programs; adding a new section to chapter 70.185 RCW; creating a new section; and making an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Sec. 1. (1) The demand for behavioral health and 5 NEW SECTION. 6 mental health care expertise exceeds the availability of those services throughout the state. Washington state has many highly 7 8 competent and committed professionals working hard to deliver behavioral health services. However, there 9 are difficulties 10 recruiting, educating, training, and retaining a skilled behavioral health care workforce. There is a need to support pathways to 11 12 behavioral health disciplines and incentivize individuals to fill 13 these essential positions.

14 (2) The area health education centers of eastern and western 15 Washington play an integral role in the development of the behavioral 16 health workforce by collaborating with the education system to 17 increase equity in behavioral health workforce education, reduce the 18 stigma around behavioral health, improve behavioral health literacy, 19 and encourage Washingtonians to join and support the behavioral 20 health workforce. The area health education centers serve rural and urban underserved communities by improving the academic pathway and
education options for health workforce development.

3 (3) It is the intent of the legislature to further support and 4 expand behavioral health workforce pathway programs provided by the 5 area health education centers to meet the behavioral health workforce 6 demands in this state.

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 70.185 8 RCW to read as follows:

9 (1) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this 10 specific purpose, the department shall receive funds from the state 11 and provide them to both eastern and western Washington area health 12 education centers for the purpose of supporting and expanding current 13 behavioral health workforce academic and career pathway programs.

14 (2) For the purposes of this section, "area health education 15 center" has the same meaning as the program identified and referred 16 to in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 294a.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The sum of one million one hundred 18 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is 19 appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, from the 20 general fund to the department of health for the purposes of this 21 act.
