- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.17.120 and 2010 c 161 s 513 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) Before accepting an application for a certificate of title
- 8 for a vehicle previously registered in any other state or country,
- 9 the department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent appointed
- 10 by the director shall require the applicant to pay a fee of fifteen
- 11 dollars. The fifteen dollar fee must be distributed under RCW
- 12 46.68.020.
- 13 (2) An applicant is exempt from the fifteen dollar fee if the
- 14 applicant previously registered the vehicle in Washington state and
- 15 <u>maintained ownership of the vehicle while registered in another state</u>
- 16 <u>or country.</u>
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2020.
