4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.68.113 (Preservation rating
6 information—Review) and 2017 c 139 s 1, 2013 c 306 s 704, 2011 c 353
7 s 7, 2006 c 334 s 21, & 2003 c 363 s 305 are each repealed.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 47.04
9 RCW to read as follows:

10 Given the importance of cost-effective asset management and
11 maintaining a state of good repair, the department shall continue to
12 collect preservation rating information for all types of highways for
13 which it collects this information as of the effective date of this
14 section.
