1        AN ACT Relating to creating a new on-premises endorsement for  
2 domestic wineries, domestic breweries, and microbreweries; and adding  
3 a new section to chapter 66.24 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**    A new section is added to chapter 66.24  
6 RCW to read as follows:

7        (1) There is an on-premises endorsement available to any:

8        (a) Licensed domestic winery to sell beer, produced in  
9 Washington, by the single serving for on-premises consumption; and

10       (b) Licensed domestic brewery or microbrewery to sell wine,  
11 produced in Washington, by the single serving for on-premises  
12 consumption.

13       (2) The holder of the endorsement is limited to three offerings  
14 of beer for a domestic winery and three offerings of wine for a  
15 domestic brewery or microbrewery.

16       (3) The annual fee for the endorsement is two hundred dollars for  
17 each retail location.
