- AN ACT Relating to the authority of counties to vacate a county road that abuts on a body of water if the county road is hazardous or
- 3 creates a significant risk to public safety; amending RCW 36.87.130;
- 4 and providing an expiration date.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. RCW 36.87.130 and 1969 ex.s. c 185 s 7 are each amended to read as follows:
- No county shall vacate a county road or part thereof which abuts on a body of salt or freshwater unless:
- 10 <u>(1) The purpose of the vacation is to enable any public authority</u> 11 to acquire the vacated property for port purposes, boat moorage or
- 12 launching sites, or for park, viewpoint, recreational, educational  $_{\it L}$
- or other public purposes ((, or unless));
- 14 <u>(2) The property is zoned for industrial uses; or</u>
- 15 (3) In a county west of the crest of the Cascade mountains and
- 16 bordered by the Columbia river with a population over four hundred
- 17 <u>fifty thousand, the county determines that:</u>
- (a) The road has been used as an access point to trespass onto
- 19 private property;
- 20 (b) Such trespass has caused loss of human life, and that public
- 21 <u>use of the county road creates an ongoing risk to public safety; and</u>

- 1 (c) Public access to the same body of water abutting the county
- 2 <u>road is available at not less than three public access sites within</u>
- 3 two miles in any direction of the terminus of the road subject to
- 4 <u>vacation</u>.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act expires December 31,
- 6 2023.
