EFFECT: Removes language added to the voter registration oath that requires registrants to declare that they have not been judicially declared mentally incompetent, and instead restores language under current law that requires a person to declare that they are not disgualified from voting due to a court order.

Changes the effective date of the act to January 1, 2022, and makes conforming changes by removing provisions that allow counties to use existing printed election material for elections in 2021 if an insert is included with the ballot explaining the changes under the bill.
