10 insert "including, but not limited to, African American, Latino
11 American, Native American, Pacific Islander American, and Asian
12 American communities, religious minorities, protest and activist
13 groups, and other vulnerable communities"

15 On page 3, line 5 of the striking amendment, after "designee;"
16 insert "the director of the department of licensing, or the director's
17 designee; the director of the office of equity, or the director's
18 designee;"

EFFECT: Adds a privacy expert as a member of the work group.
Adds the Director of the Department of Licensing and the Director of
the Office of Equity, or their designees, as ex officio members of
the work group. Provides examples of protected classes of
communities historically impacted by surveillance technologies and
bias in technology-based systems.
