Office of Equity;

Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises; and

Governor's Office of Indian Affairs.

Requires the board to describe the involvement of these entities in the further development of the equity committee and provide it to

the Department of Commerce for inclusion in the annual report to the legislature.

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
