1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The criminal justice training
4 commission shall convene a work group to make recommendations
5 regarding when a peace officer must intervene or report wrongdoing
6 observed by another peace officer.

7 (2) The work group must include:

8 (a) One representative from the superior court judges
9 association;

10 (b) One representative from the Washington association of
11 prosecuting attorneys;

12 (c) Two community members with experience in police
13 accountability;

14 (d) One member who is a police chief or sheriff;

15 (e) One member who is a law enforcement officer; and

16 (f) One member of the defense bar.

17 (3) (a) The work group shall make recommendations regarding:

18 (i) Elements that should be included in a model policy regarding
19 a peace officer's duty to intervene; and

20 (ii) Other instances in which a peace officer should be required
21 to report conduct of another officer.

22 (b) In making its recommendations, the work group must consider:

23 (i) The status of the reporting officer and status of the officer
24 being reported;

25 (ii) The definition of wrongdoing that should be reported by
26 peace officers;

27 (iii) The impact of reporting or failure to report on a peace
28 officer's certification; and

29 (iv) The relation of these issues to collective bargaining.

30 (4) The work group must report its recommendations to the
31 governor and the appropriate committees of the legislature no later
32 than December 1, 2021.

33 (5) The work group must operate within existing funds.

1 (6) This section expires June 30, 2022."

2 On page 1, line 1, of the title, after "intervene;" strike the
3 remainder of the title and insert "creating a new section; and
4 providing an expiration date."

EFFECT: Establishes a work group convened by the Criminal Justice Training Commission to make recommendations regarding when a peace officer must intervene or report wrongdoing observed by another peace officer.
