- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The criminal justice training commission shall convene a work group to make recommendations regarding when a peace officer must intervene or report wrongdoing observed by another peace officer.
 - (2) The work group must include:
- 8 (a) One representative from the superior court judges 9 association;
- 10 (b) One representative from the Washington association of 11 prosecuting attorneys;
- 12 (c) Two community members with experience in police 13 accountability;
- 14 (d) One member who is a police chief or sheriff;
- 15 (e) One member who is a law enforcement officer; and
- 16 (f) One member of the defense bar.
- 17 (3) (a) The work group shall make recommendations regarding:
- 18 (i) Elements that should be included in a model policy regarding 19 a peace officer's duty to intervene; and
- 20 (ii) Other instances in which a peace officer should be required 21 to report conduct of another officer.
 - (b) In making its recommendations, the work group must consider:
