2 through "website." on line 21 and insert "Prior to beginning a
3 project to provide retail telecommunications services in this
4 subsection, a public utility district must: (i) Notify the governor's
5 statewide broadband office, established in RCW 43.330.532, of its
6 intent to provide such services; (ii) provide a detailed plan of what
7 facilities it intends to build including, but not limited to, a
8 specific description of where it intends to build facilities and what
9 facilities it intends to construct; and (iii) post a notice of intent
10 and a copy of its plan on its public website. The governor's
11 statewide broadband office must post notices and plans received from
12 a public utility district pursuant to this subsection on its public
13 website and provide notice of the posting to each incumbent local
14 exchange company whose service area is affected by a notice of
15 intent."

16 On page 8, beginning on line 3, after "(a)" strike all material
17 through "website." on line 14 and insert "Prior to beginning a
18 project to provide retail telecommunications services in this
19 subsection, a port district must: (i) Notify the governor's statewide
20 broadband office, established in RCW 43.330.532, of its intent to
21 provide such services; (ii) provide a detailed plan of what
22 facilities it intends to build including, but not limited to, a
23 specific description of where it intends to build facilities and what
24 facilities it intends to construct; and (iii) post a notice of intent
25 and a copy of its plan on its public website. The governor's
26 statewide broadband office must post notices and plans received from
27 a port district pursuant to this subsection on its public website and
28 provide notice of the posting to each incumbent local exchange
29 company whose service area is affected by a notice of intent."

EFFECT: Specifies the requirements public utility districts and port districts must fulfill prior to beginning a project to provide retail telecommunications services. Requires the governor's statewide broadband office to notify each incumbent local exchange company

whose service area is affected by a public utility district's or port district's intent to provide retail telecommunications services.

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
