

**SSB 5693 - S AMD 1234**

ADOPTED 02/25/2022

1 On page 460, line 35, increase the General Fund—State  
2 Appropriation (FY 2023) by \$3,510,000

3 Adjust the total appropriation accordingly.

4 On page 476, after line 7, insert the following:

5 "(73) \$3,510,000 of the general fund—state appropriation for  
6 fiscal year 2023 is provided solely for grants for the following  
7 activities:

8 (a) \$900,000 for the Lummi Nation to make infrastructure updates  
9 at the Skookum hatchery;

10 (b) \$250,000 for the Confederated Tribes of the Colville  
11 Reservation to upgrade heating, ventilation, and air conditioning  
12 systems at the Colville trout hatchery, and to acquire a hatchery  
13 fish transport truck with aquaculture adaptations;

14 (c) \$230,000 for the Yakama Nation to incorporate rearing vessels  
15 at the Cle Elum facility and to build circular covers at the lower  
16 Yakima facility;

17 (d) \$1,180,000 to the Puyallup Tribe to build an augmentation  
18 well at Voights creek hatchery, upgrade the water supply system and  
19 alarms at the Clarks creek hatchery, and convert rearing ponds into  
20 eight raceways at Diru creek chum hatchery;

21 (e) \$600,000 to the Suquamish Tribe to install an abatement pond  
22 at Grovers creek hatchery and replace raceways at Gorst coho  
23 raceways; and

24 (f) \$350,000 to the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe to upgrade water  
25 supply systems at Point Whitney and expand shellfish seed production  
26 capacity at the shellfish hatchery in Kona."

EFFECT: Provides funding for the Department of Fish and Wildlife to make specific grant amounts to specified tribes for hatchery related projects and upgrades.
