Brief Description: Making supplemental transportation appropriations for the 2021-2023 fiscal biennium.

Sponsors: Senate Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Senators Liias, Saldaña, Nguyen, Nobles and Wilson, C.; by request of Office of Financial Management).

Senate Committee on Transportation

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium, making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary: The 2021-23 appropriations for various state transportation agencies and programs are modified. Budget summary materials can be found at fiscal.wa.gov.
