- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring private operation of publicly owned
- 2 sewerage systems that fail to achieve minimum water quality
- 3 performance; and adding a new section to chapter 90.48 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.48 6 RCW to read as follows:
- A public entity required to obtain a permit under RCW 90.48.162
- 8 for the disposal of waste material into the waters of the state must
- 9 contract, after competitive solicitation, for the operation and
- 10 maintenance of the public entity's waste disposal system within 12
- 11 months of events satisfying either of the following criteria:
- 12 (1) Sewage, sewage-contaminated wastewater, or sewage-
- 13 contaminated stormwater are discharged in violation of the permit
- 14 issued under this chapter in a volume that exceeds 500,000 gallons in
- 15 a single discharge event; or
- 16 (2) Sewage, sewage-contaminated wastewater, or sewage-
- 17 contaminated stormwater are discharged in violation of the permit
- 18 issued under this chapter in a volume that exceeds 50,000 gallons in

- 1 a single discharge event five or more times during any continuous 24-
- 2 month period.
