- AN ACT Relating to prohibiting public schools from requiring
- 2 students to eat or drink outside school buildings; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 28A.210 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.210 6 RCW to read as follows:
- Public schools with students in any of grades kindergarten through eight may not require students to eat or drink outside school
- 9 buildings. Students may opt in to eating or drinking outside when the
- 10 outdoor temperature is 60 degrees or above and there is no
- 11 precipitation. For the purpose of this section, "public schools" has
- 12 the same meaning as in RCW 28A.150.010.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
- 15 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes
- 16 effect immediately.
