1 WHEREAS, Justin R. Schaffer was born January 30, 1992, in
2 Glenwood Springs, Colorado, and graduated from Adna High School in
3 Adna, Washington; and

4 WHEREAS, Justin Schaffer received a degree in criminal justice
5 from Centralia College; and

6 WHEREAS, Justin Schaffer served his community honorably as a
7 Washington State trooper in both Morton and Chehalis for seven years
8 of service to the citizens of this state and his community; and

9 WHEREAS, Trooper Justin Schaffer, while in the line of duty, was
10 fatally struck by a vehicle on Interstate 5 in Chehalis on March 24,
11 2020; and

12 WHEREAS, Trooper Justin Schaffer will be missed dearly by his
13 brothers and sisters in the law enforcement family, and his spirit of
14 service will continue through the lives he impacted, as well as those
15 he touched throughout the community; and

16 WHEREAS, Trooper Justin Schaffer was not only a loving son and
17 brother, but also devoted to his wife, Sandra, his mother, Sheila,
18 and father, Glenn; his brother, Brandon; and his K9 partner, Frankie;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State House
20 of Representatives express its deepest condolences to the family,
21 friends, colleagues, and community that have lost Trooper Justin
22 Schaffer; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives join
2 the people of the State of Washington in commending, saluting, and
3 honoring Trooper Justin Schaffer for his exemplary and exceptional
4 service; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives express
6 profound appreciation and enduring gratitude to the brave men and
7 women that protect our state every day as law enforcement officers;

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
