- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating the crime of interfering with a
- 2 firefighter or emergency medical services provider; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 9A.84 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.84 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A person is guilty of interfering with a firefighter or 8 emergency medical services provider if the person, with knowledge 9 that another person is a firefighter or emergency medical services 10 provider, intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent that 11 firefighter or emergency medical services provider from performing
- 12 his or her official duties.
- 13 (2) Interfering with a firefighter or emergency medical services 14 provider is a gross misdemeanor.
  - (3) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Emergency medical services provider" includes any person who
- 17 is an emergency medical technician or a first responder as defined in
- 18 RCW 18.73.030 and any person who is a physician's trained advanced
- 19 emergency medical technician and paramedic as defined in RCW
- 20 18.71.200.
