- 5 (1) Any person of the age of ((eighteen)) 18 years or over shall be eligible to donate blood, including donation through apheresis, in 6 7 any voluntary and noncompensatory blood program without the necessity 8 of obtaining parental permission or authorization.
- (2) Any person between the ages of 16 and 17 years old shall be 9 10 eligible to donate blood, including donation through apheresis, in 11 any voluntary and noncompensatory blood program after obtaining
- 12 parental or legal quardian permission or authorization.
