- There shall be in the counties of Benton and Franklin jointly, seven judges of the superior court; in the county of Clallam, three judges of the superior court; in the county of Jefferson, one judge of the superior court; in the county of Snohomish, ((fifteen)) 17 judges of the superior court; in the counties of Asotin, Columbia and Garfield jointly, one judge of the superior court; in the county of
- 12 Cowlitz, five judges of the superior court; in the counties of
- 13 Klickitat and Skamania jointly, one judge of the superior court.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) The additional judicial positions
- 15 created in section 1 of this act are effective only if Snohomish
- 16 county, through its duly constituted legislative authority, documents
- 17 its approval of the additional positions and its agreement that it
- 18 will pay out of county funds, without reimbursement from the state,
- 19 the expenses of the additional judicial positions as provided by
- 20 state law and the state Constitution.
