- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29A.84.610 and 2003 c 111 s 2127 are each amended to read as follows:
 - A person is guilty of a gross misdemeanor who knowingly:
- 7 (1) Deceives any voter in recording his or her vote by providing 8 incorrect or misleading recording information or by providing faulty 9 election equipment or records; ((or))
- 10 (2) Records the vote of any voter in a manner other than as 11 designated by the voter; or
- 12 <u>(3) Misrepresents an unofficial ballot collection site or device</u> 13 <u>as an official ballot drop box that has been established by the</u>
- 14 county auditor.

Such a gross misdemeanor is punishable to the same extent as a gross misdemeanor that is punishable under RCW 9A.20.021.
