4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 4.24.420 and 1987 c 212 s 901 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 ((It)) (1) Except in an action arising out of law enforcement 8 activities resulting in personal injury or death, it is a complete 9 defense to any action for damages for personal injury or wrongful 10 death that the person injured or killed was engaged in the commission 11 of a felony at the time of the occurrence causing the injury or death 12 and the felony was a proximate cause of the injury or death. 13 ((However, nothing))

14 (2) In an action arising out of law enforcement activities 15 resulting in personal injury or death, it is a complete defense to 16 the action that the finder of fact has determined beyond a reasonable 17 doubt that the person injured or killed was engaged in the commission 18 of a felony at the time of the occurrence causing the injury or 19 death, the commission of which was a proximate cause of the injury or 20 death. 1 <u>(3) Nothing</u> in this section shall affect a right of action under 2 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1983.
