1 AN ACT Relating to state funding for educational service
2 districts; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.310 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.310
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 State funding shall be provided to each educational service
7 district for the employer cost of school employees' benefits that are
8 provided to employees of an educational service district that are
9 covered by a collective bargaining agreement.
