       ((This act)) Chapter 144, Laws of 2020 takes effect the later of
22 January 1, 2021, or the date that the board for volunteer firefighters
23 and reserve officers receives notice from the federal internal revenue
24 service that the volunteer firefighters ((and reserve officers relief
25 and pension system))plan is a qualified employee benefit plan under
26 the federal law. The board must provide written notice of the
27 effective date of this act to affected parties, the chief clerk of the
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- 1 house of representatives, the secretary of the senate, the office of
- 2 the code reviser, and others as deemed appropriate by the board."

EFFECT: Changes the date at which funds are transferred from the combined Volunteer Firefighters' and Reserve Officers' relief and pension fund to the separate funds for the plans created in the bill from July 1, 2023 to August 1, 2023. Removes the requirement for the State Treasurer to request that the State Investment Board invest the funds of the two plans. Removes an effective date that is contingent on the plan being qualified by the federal Internal Revenue Service (IRS) without the plan being divided, which is inconsistent with the terms of the bill that divide the plan. Changes the contingent effective date provision for benefits from Chapter 144, Laws of 2020 (ESSB 5829) to require IRS approval of the separate Volunteer Firefighters' plan, not the combined Volunteer Firefighters' and Reserve Officers' plan that is divided in the bill.

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
