1 On page 5, at the beginning of line 11 of the striking amendment,
2 strike "(13)" and insert "~~((13))~~ (11)(a) State universities, regional
3 universities, and the state college, as defined in RCW 28B.10.016,
4 offering college in the high school courses shall coordinate with an
5 organization representing the presidents of the public four-year
6 institutions of higher education, and the community and technical
7 colleges offering college in the high school courses shall coordinate
8 with the state board for community and technical colleges to each
9 prepare a report, each disaggregated by institution of higher
10 education, that includes:

11 (i) Data about student participation rates, award of high school
12 credit, award of postsecondary credit at an institution of higher
13 education, academic performance, and subsequent enrollment in an
14 institution of higher education;

15 (ii) Geographic data on college in the high school courses,
16 including the name, number, location of courses, and student
17 enrollment disaggregated by school districts and high schools;

18 (iii) Data on college in the high school student demographics,
19 including race, ethnicity, gender, and receipt of free or reduced-
20 price lunch; and

21 (iv) Recommendations on additional categories of data reporting
22 and disaggregation.

23 (b) Beginning September 1, 2024, and each year thereafter, the
24 reports must be submitted to the appropriate committees of the
25 legislature in accordance with RCW 43.01.036.

EFFECT: Adds a range of annual data reporting requirements on College in the High School (CHS) courses, to be completed by institutions of higher education as defined in the bill, including data on student participation and enrollment, academic performance, geographic data on CHS courses, and student demographics.

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
