<u>EFFECT:</u> (1) Permits four-year not-for-profit institutions of higher education meeting delineated requirements, including requirements related to founding date and location on tribal land, to enter into student data-sharing agreements with the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) for the purposes of informing Washington high school students of postsecondary educational opportunities available in the state.

(2) Makes changes to reflect the potential inclusion of qualifying four-year not-for-profit institutions of higher education in data-sharing agreements, including establishing a definition of "institutions of higher education" and adding that definition to a reformatted list of definitions established in the underlying striking amendment.
