3 "Sec. 1. RCW 2.36.100 and 2015 c 7 s 2 are each amended to read 4 as follows:

5 (1) Except for a person who is not qualified for jury service 6 under RCW 2.36.070 <u>or who chooses to opt out of jury service under</u> 7 <u>subsection (2) of this section</u>, no person may be excused from jury 8 service by the court except upon a showing of undue hardship, extreme 9 inconvenience, public necessity, or any reason deemed sufficient by 10 the court for a period of time the court deems necessary.

11 (2) <u>A person who is 80 years of age or older may request to be</u> 12 <u>excused from jury service if the person attests that the person is</u> 13 <u>unable to serve due to health reasons. An attestation form must be</u> 14 <u>developed by the court and may not include a requirement that a</u> 15 <u>doctor's note be provided. This request must be granted by the court.</u>

(3) At the discretion of the court's designee, after a request by 16 17 a prospective juror to be excused, a prospective juror excused from juror service for a particular time may be assigned to another jury 18 term within the twelve-month period. If the assignment to another 19 20 jury term is made at the time a juror is excused from the jury term 21 for which he or she was summoned, a second summons under RCW 2.36.095 22 need not be issued. This subsection does not apply to people excused from jury service under subsection (2) of this section. 23

24 ((-(3))) (4) When the jury source list has been fully summoned within a consecutive twelve-month period and additional jurors are 25 needed, jurors who have already served during the consecutive twelve-26 27 month period may be summoned again for service. A juror who has previously served may only be excused if he or she served at least 28 one week of juror service within the preceding twelve months. An 29 30 excuse for prior service shall be granted only upon the written 31 request of the prospective juror, which request shall certify the 32 terms of prior service. Prior jury service may include service in

- 1 superior court, in a court of limited jurisdiction, in the United 2 States District Court, or on a jury of inquest."
