5 (1) Review and evaluate prosecutor and public defender caseloads 6 regarding personal restraint petitions;

7 (2) Identify the effects of personal restraint petitions on court8 resources; and

9 (3) Report findings and recommendations to the appropriate fiscal 10 and policy committees of the legislature not later than December 1, 11 2024."

12 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct any 13 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires the office of public defense, in consultation with the Washington association of prosecuting attorneys, to study and evaluate the effects of personal restraint petitions on prosecutor caseloads, public defender caseloads, and court resources. Requires the office of public defense to report findings and recommendations to the legislature by December 1, 2024.
