**NOT ADOPTED 03/02/2023**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 7.48  
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) By December 1, 2024, the attorney general shall complete a  
6 study of the insurance impacts to firearm industry members, meaning  
7 entities engaged in the wholesale or retail sale, manufacturing,  
8 distribution, importing, or marketing of firearms or related  
9 products, if any or all of the following become law:

10 (a) A requirement that firearm industry members not knowingly  
11 create, maintain, or contribute to a public nuisance in this state  
12 through the sale, manufacturing, distribution, importing, or  
13 marketing of firearms or related products;

14 (b) A requirement that firearm industry members establish,  
15 implement, and enforce reasonable controls regarding the manufacture,  
16 sale, distribution, importing, use, and marketing of firearm industry  
17 products; or

18 (c) A requirement that firearm industry members not manufacture,  
19 distribute, import, market, offer for wholesale, or offer for retail  
20 sale firearms or related products that are:

21 (i) Designed, sold, or marketed in a manner that foreseeably  
22 promotes conversion of legal firearms or related products into  
23 illegal firearms or related products; or

24 (ii) Designed, sold, or marketed in a manner that is targeted at  
25 minors or individuals who are legally prohibited from possessing or  
26 purchasing firearms.

27 (2) On or before December 1, 2024, the attorney general shall  
28 submit the findings of the study to the appropriate committees of the  
29 legislature and shall publish the findings on the attorney general's  
30 website."

**NOT ADOPTED 03/02/2023**

1       On page 1, line 10 of the title, after "general;" strike the  
2 remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new section to  
3 chapter 7.48 RCW."

EFFECT: Requires the attorney general to study the insurance impacts to firearm industry members if certain regulatory measures and duties become law.
