- On page 541, after line 31, insert the following:

- 21 lions under the marine mammal protection act section 120(f) permit in
- 22 tributaries of the Columbia river where federally listed salmon spawn
- 23 and in the mainstem above river mile 112. The department must

<u>EFFECT:</u> Funding is reduced at the department of commerce. The provision for assistance in Cowlitz county for homelessness is shifted to existing appropriations for homelessness and housing assistance, with specific funding to the city of Longview. Funding is provided to the department of fish and wildlife to remove sea lions and other salmon conservation activities on the Columbia river.
