1 On page 12, beginning on line 13, strike all of subsection (1) 2 and insert the following:

"(1) The governing authority of an electric utility formed under this chapter may adopt an electrification of transportation plan that, at a minimum, establishes a finding that utility outreach and investment in the electrification of transportation infrastructure does not increase net costs to ratepayers in excess of one-quarter of one percent."

9 On page 13, beginning on line 12, strike all of subsection (1) 10 and insert the following:

11 "(1) The commission of a public utility district may adopt an 12 electrification of transportation plan that, at a minimum, 13 establishes a finding that outreach and investment in the 14 electrification of transportation infrastructure does not increase 15 net costs to ratepayers in excess of one-quarter of one percent."

16 On page 14, beginning on line 11, strike all of subsection (1) 17 and insert the following:

"(1) In establishing rates for each electrical company regulated 18 under this title, the commission may allow an incentive rate of 19 20 return on investment through December 31, 2030, on capital 21 expenditures for electric vehicle supply equipment that is deployed for the benefit of ratepayers, provided that the capital expenditures 22 of the utilities' programs or plans in RCW 80.28.365(1) do not 23 24 increase the annual retail revenue requirement of the utility, after 25 accounting for the benefits of transportation electrification in each year of the plan, in excess of one-quarter of one percent. The 26 27 commission must consider and may adopt other policies to improve access to and promote fair competition in the provision of electric 28 vehicle supply equipment." 29
