Synopsis as Enacted

Brief Description: Concerning the capital budget.

Sponsors: Senate Committee on Ways & Means (originally sponsored by Senators Mullet, Schoesler and Nguyen; by request of Office of Financial Management).

Senate Committee on Ways & Means

Background: The capital expenses of state government, and its agencies and programs, are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus capital budget adopted by the Legislature in oddnumbered years. State capital expenses are paid from state general obligation bonds and from various dedicated funds and accounts.

Summary: Biennial appropriations for the 2023-25 fiscal biennium and supplemental appropriations for the 2021-23 fiscal biennium for the various agencies and programs of the state are enacted, including appropriations for general government agencies, human services programs, natural resources agencies, and educational institutions.
