- AN ACT Relating to requiring employers to reimburse employees for necessary expenditures and losses; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 49.12 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.12 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) An employer shall reimburse an employee for all necessary 8 expenditures and losses incurred by the employee in direct 9 consequence of the discharge of the employee's duties. Reimbursement 10 must be paid within 30 days of the employer's actual or constructive 11 notice of the expenditure or loss.
- 12 (2) If an employer does not reimburse the employee as required 13 under this section, the employee may bring a civil cause of action. 14 If the employee prevails, the court shall award the employee 15 reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred to enforce this 16 section. Awards carry interest at the same rate as civil judgments 17 under RCW 4.56.110. Interest accrues from the date on which the 18 employee incurred the necessary expenditure or loss.

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
