1 AN ACT Relating to training for tribal police officers and
2 employees; and amending RCW 43.101.230.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.101.230 and 2021 c 323 s 15 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Tribal police officers and employees who are engaged in law
7 enforcement activities and who do not qualify as "criminal justice
8 personnel" or "law enforcement personnel" under RCW 43.101.010 shall
9 be provided training under this chapter if: (~~(a) [(1)]~~) (1) The
10 tribe is recognized by the federal government, and (~~(b) [(2)]~~ the
11 tribe pays) (2) tribal agencies with tribal officer certification
12 agreements with the commission under RCW 43.101.157 shall reimburse
13 the commission for 25 percent of the cost of training its personnel.
14 Tribes without current written tribal officer certification
15 agreements with the commission shall pay to the commission the full
16 cost of providing such training. The commission shall place all money
17 received under this section into the criminal justice training
18 account.
