- 1 AN ACT Relating to increasing the health care workforce by 2 authorizing out-of-state providers to practice immediately; and
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 18.79 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.79 6 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) The department shall issue an expedited temporary license to practice as a registered nurse, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or licensed practical nurse to a person who:
- 10 (a) Holds a current license to practice as a registered nurse, 11 advanced registered nurse practitioner, or licensed practical nurse 12 issued by a professional licensing board in California, Idaho, or 13 Oregon;
 - (b) Provides to the commission, in a manner determined by the commission, sufficient proof that the person is in good standing with the issuing out-of-state professional licensing board; and
- 17 (c) Submits a completed national background check fingerprint 18 card, if required.
- 19 (2) An expedited temporary license issued under this section 20 permits a person to practice as a registered nurse, advanced 21 registered nurse practitioner, or licensed practical nurse in

- 1 Washington, pending the results of the fingerprint-based national
- 2 background check, to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the
- 3 commission and the department, and is valid until the earliest of the

- (a) Two years after the date of issuance; or
- 6 (b) The date the person's authorization issued by the 7 professional licensing board in California, Idaho, or Oregon expires.
- 8 (3) An expedited temporary license issued under this section is 9 not renewable.
