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- 1 AN ACT Relating to allowing certain minors to contract for
- 2 housing and utilities; adding a new section to chapter 26.28 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that adolescents are
- 6 without stable housing due to familial conflicts, financial strain,
- 7 or other unforeseen circumstances. The inability to sign rental
- 8 agreements presents a significant barrier in a system meant to be
- 9 compassionate and flexible and can prevent youths from accessing safe
- 10 shelter. Court delays and an inability to access services also
- 11 prevent youths from accessing shelter through foster care or other
- 12 state systems. Therefore, the legislature intends to allow
- 13 unaccompanied minors to sign rental agreements in order to prevent
- 14 unnecessary youth homelessness.
- 15 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 26.28
- 16 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 (1) A minor who is at least 16 years old and living apart from a
- 18 parent, quardian, or legal custodian may contract for a residential
- 19 dwelling unit and utility services to the unit.

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(2) A contract or lease executed by a minor under this section is binding and may not be voided or disaffirmed by the minor due to the minor's age or status as a minor. The consent of a parent, guardian, or legal custodian is not necessary for a minor to contract for a residential dwelling unit or utility services to the unit. A parent, guardian, or legal custodian is not liable for a contract by a minor for a residential dwelling unit or utility services unless the parent, guardian, or legal custodian is a party to the contract or enters a contract as a guarantor for the minor's debt.

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
